**International DN Ice Yacht Racing Association
2023 Gold Cup World Championship Regatta
And North American Championship Regatta
Racing January 22 - January 28, 2023**

The Western Lakes Region and Regatta Chair Chris Berger (US-5166), on behalf of the IDNIYRA, hereby invites all DN iceboaters to participate in the 2023 Gold Cup World Championship Regatta and the North American Championship Regatta.

RULES

- All races will be governed by the Racing Rules of the National Iceboat Authority, the Bylaws of the IDNIYRA, Regatta Management Agreement, the Notice of Race, including any amendments to the Notice of Race, (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and the Sailing instructions.

RACE SYSTEM

- Races will be sailed under the rules of the National Iceboat Authority and those of the IDNIYRA.
- Each regatta is scheduled for 7 races per fleet.
- The number of Fleets and fleet size will be determined after registration.
- Race results and starting positions may be texted to competitors between races and will be posted on-ice near the center of the starting line.

RACE COURSE

- All courses will be a WINDWARD / LEEWARD Inline course and may include Darling Marks.
- A diagram of the race course will be posted on the online Official Notice Board.
- All races will be 3 Laps unless altered by the Race Committee.

ELIGIBILITY

- All DN class yachts meeting the requirements of the DN official specifications and whose skipper meets the requirements of the bylaws of the IDNIYRA are eligible to enter and race in the championship regattas.
- All participants must provide proof of \$300,000 personal liability insurance at time of Registration.
- No sailor may compete in the 2023 Gold Cup or North American Championship using a plank supplied by or built by Peter Hamrak or Ice wise, unless a Technical Committee member has determined the Hamrak/Icewise plank complies with the Official Specification.

REGISTRATION, DEADLINE AND FEE

- Entry Fee must be paid in U.S. Dollars.

***REGISTRATION MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE OR POSTMARKED BY DECEMBER 31, 2022
TO AVOID LATE FEES.***

- The entry fee for the **GOLD CUP WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP** are as follows:
 - \$150.00 (USD) if paid online or by mail by December 31, 2022.
 - \$200.00 (USD) if paid on or after January 1, 2023.
- The entry fee for a Junior Skipper (25 or under at the time of registration) is \$70.00 (USD).

- The entry fee for the **NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP** are as follows:
 - \$140.00 (USD) if paid online or by mail by December 31, 2022.
 - \$190.00 (USD) if paid on or after January 1, 2023.
- The entry fee for a Junior Skipper (25 or under at the time of registration) is \$60.00 (USD).
- No entry fee will be accepted after each event's close of registration (refer to schedule of events). When the regatta location moves prior to the first race, registration may be reopened
- Novice DN skippers may enter the Regatta with the payment of two years association dues. No other event registration payments will apply.
 - A Novice DN skipper is a skipper that has never belonged to the IDNIYRA, or their membership has lapsed for 5 or more years and complies with all other entry requirements.
- European and Junior Skippers are not subject to a late fee penalty. European competitors are requested to notify the Class Secretary at secretary.idniyra@gmail.com that they will be attending.

IMPORTANT DATES

- December 31, 2022: Registration Deadline for early entry fee.
- January 18, 2023, 9:00 pm, CST: Site info to be posted on IDNIYRA website
- January 21, 2021, Registration 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm local time: Location to be listed on the IDNIYRA website.
- January 22, 2023 first World Gold Cup race at time stated in sailing instructions.
- PRIZES to be awarded after the Completion of World Gold Cup.
- January 23, 2023, earliest possible North American Championship Registration: 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm local time. Location and updated date, time and place to be listed on the IDNIYRA website.
- January 24, 2023 earliest possible race in North American Championship, at time stated in sailing instructions.

- January 28, 2023 racing is concluded. PRIZES shall be awarded after the regatta is completed.

AWARDS

- Awards will be presented after the regatta is completed.
- Awards will be presented for First thru Tenth place in each fleet, plus the 1st Grand Master, 1st Master, 1st Senior, 1st Woman, 1st Junior and 1st Novice in the regatta.
